COVID-19 CODE OF CONDUCT

We are some of the privileged few able to watch competitive football at this current time. Please make sure we can continue by complying with our Code of Conduct.

For your safety, and the safety of others, please make sure to observe the following whilst at our Stadium. Please note these may all be subject to amendment and addition in the coming days, weeks and months ahead, so please check for updates. Failure to comply may lead to refusal of entry and / or expulsion from the ground.

- Observe all social distancing protocols at all times, whether inside or outside the Main Stadium.
- Respect the Government rule of 6
- Please be aware new systems of entry, throughflow within the stadium and exit may lead to delays. Please plan accordingly and be patient with others.
- Face-coverings will be required when entering through the turnstiles and when using the toilets.
- Comply with any health checks that may be required on entering the ground. Be aware, your temperature may be taken upon entry.
- Do not attend if you have signs of a fever or high temperature (above 38°C)
- Do not attend if you have a persistent cough or respiratory problems
- Do not attend if you have had contact with any possible source of the virus
- Do not attend if you have lost your sense of taste or smell
- Track and Trace procedures are in place and you will be required to supply personal details in line with our GDPR policy
- Where possible, download the evePASS app on your phone before arriving, to simplify your registration for Track and Trace procedures.
- Where possible all payments within the ground should be made via cashless platforms.
- Regularly wash your hands, use hand sanitizer and avoid touching your face and dispose of any used tissues appropriately.
- Do not remove hand sanitizer or other personal hygiene products from their location.
- Make sure all walkways, corridors and doorways etc are clear before you walk through.
- Observe one-way systems where they are in operation.
- Avoid face-to-face contact with other spectators and avoid hugs, high fives and any contact with people.
- Follow all signage and the instructions of staff, officials or any emergency service personnel present at the ground
